

Anglophone Section Admissions and entrance exams

Anglophone section admission :

- Students at the top of their Anglais Académique classes in collège
- Students having lived abroad or in a bilingual family and who have good oral and comprehension skills but lack training in reading and writing
- Motivated students having developed strong English skills through summer programs / international experiences and diligence
- Students working up to Etudes Anglophones by perfecting their skills

Etudes Anglophones candidates must be capable of following the Education Nationale curriculum that prepares the French Baccalauréat in addition to having an excellent or bilingual-level of English.

Anglophone Section Entrance Exams

• Entrance Exams take place:

Mid-March for in-coming 6èmes

Entrance Exam

A two-hour exam including :

- 1. writing and reading skills
- 2. oral and listening skills,

to determine whether candidates have the necessary English skills to spend all their English classes with Anglophone Section teachers.

Students who successfully pass this exam are invited into **SGAS**. Students who demonstrate good English skills, but do not meet the level requirements of SGAS may be invited to attend Ecole des Langues.
